Actions for 2017 Therefore we will:

Provide iconography, sacred spaces and resources for prayer which recontextualise the Religious Life of the School particularly our Mercy charism and the message of the Holy Cross.

Monitor and refine planning for classroom teaching of Religion, especially with regard to line of sight documents to ensure alignment of Achievement standard, Learning Intentions, Success Criteria and Assessment Tasks.

Support teachers to review and develop RE assessment tasks which align with the Achievement Standards and respond to diversity of learners.

Review and respond to the effectiveness of the Scope and Sequence for Religious Education at Holy Cross

Engagement with the Dialogue School Project data collection to inform analysis of the characteristics of our school as a faith community.

Therefore we will:

Use a uniform planning template for short teaching and learning cycles in English following the BCE Model of Pedagogy and expected and effective practices.

Support teacher understanding and use of Intensive Reading Strategies and Detailed Reading as part of focussed teaching and learning in English.

Support the regular collection and analysis of Data (PM SPAT, Concepts of Print, ACER, Writing Criteria and NAPLAN) to inform future teaching and learning plans.

Implement the BCE High Yield Strategies (Learning Walks and Talks, Data Walls and Review and Response) to provide feedback to staff to support moving learning forward.

Build teacher capacity by collaborating within and beyond the school to enhance Literacy practices which support learning progress for all.

Provide Professional Development and resources to support teacher implementation of the Technologies Curriculum.

Enhance teaching and learning across the curriculum by improving access to and technical support of our digital infrastructure.
