

HOLY CROSS ENROLMENT POLICY

Holy Cross is a Catholic primary school operating under the authority of the Catholic Archdiocese of Brisbane and students will therefore be enrolled in accordance with the current Archdiocesan Enrolment Policy.

Where prospective students may require significant educational adjustments due to a disability, the school engages in partnership with parents and external support agencies to complete the Brisbane Catholic Education Enrolment Application and Support Procedures. This process reflects our ongoing commitment to inclusive practices and is guided by the principles of justice as reflected in Church, education and legal contexts.

- No Catholic student will be excluded because of inability to meet fee payments.
- Parents must be willing for their children to be involved in the school Religious Education program.
- We anticipate parents will support their children in the Parish School to which they are enrolled.
- Birth and Baptismal certificates must be presented at the initial interview. Other relevant documentation, e.g. health records, guidance records, must also be presented at that interview.
- For children seeking placement in year levels other than Prep, a Transfer Form and a report from the previously attended school will be necessary.
- Enrolment cannot be offered once the classes have reached the acceptable number.
- Enrolment in a Catholic primary school does not, in any way, ensure a place for the child in any Catholic secondary school or local college. The particular enrolment procedures for each school must be clearly followed.
